NEW CHAIRMAN FOR AUSTRALIAN AIRPORTS ASSOCIATION

The Australian Airports Association (AAA) today announced the appointment of Stephen Goodwin, General Manager of Operations - Brisbane Airport Corporation as the new Chairman of the Association.

Mr Goodwin is a Senior Executive with 18 years of senior management experience in a number of key areas, particularly in aviation and airport management. He has spent the last 14 years in various roles with Brisbane Airport Corporation in which the last 9 years have been focused on all aspects of its operations as the GM, Operations. Last year he completed the Advanced Management Program, AMP, held at INSEAD, Fontainebleau, Paris, the number 1 ranked Management School in the world, 2010.
