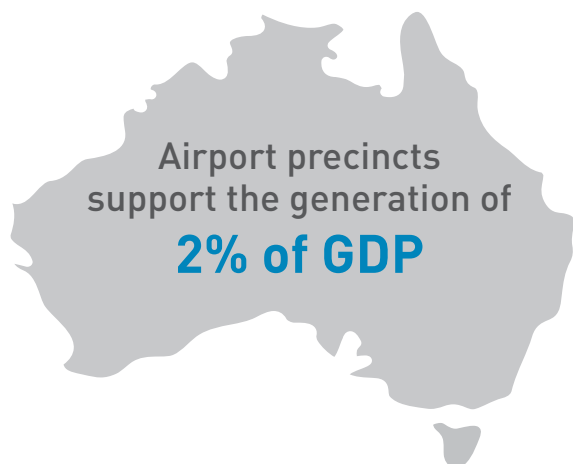
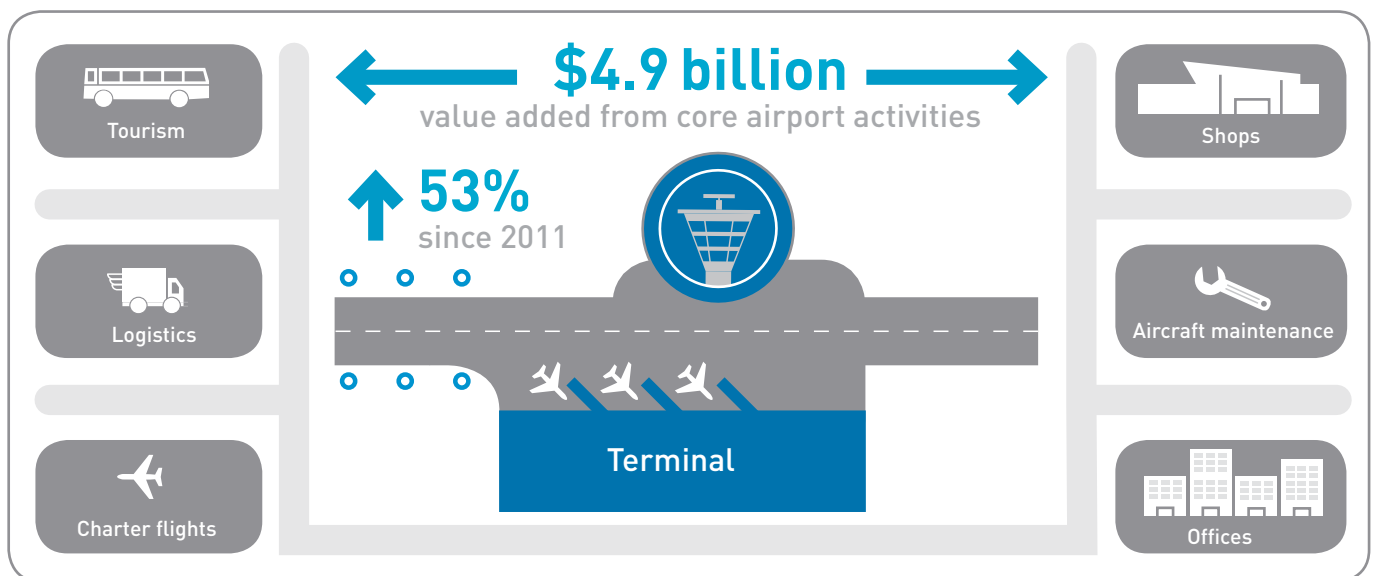

Airports add \$34.6 billion to the Australian economy each year

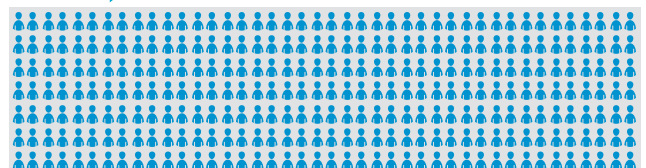

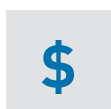
Global access and trade

Airports create a strong and vibrant economy, supporting a wide range of industries



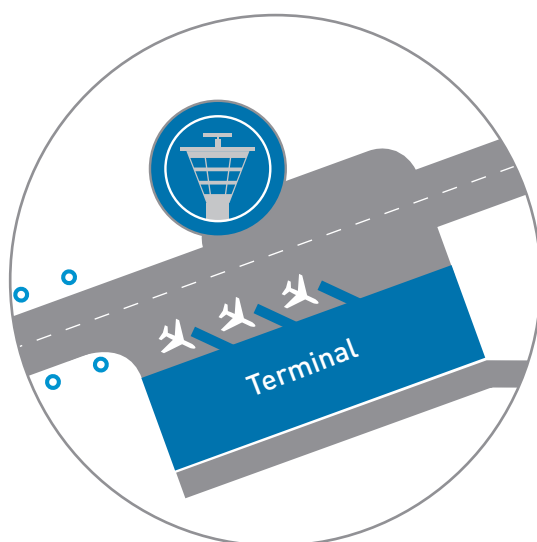
